



B.C. Spring Classic 2009
British Columbia Miniature Horse Club
2009 – Yearling & 2 Year Old Canadian Futurity
(Horses born in 2007 & 2008)

ELIGIBILITY:

The owner of the foal, registered with the AMHA and residing in Region 10 may participate in the BCMHC Canadian Futurity by complying with these rules. Nominated foal must have been born in the year of 2007 or 2008 and must reside in Area 10 in Canada. The owner of the nominated foal must live in Area 10 in Canada **and be current BCMHC member.**

OFFICIAL SHOW:

The B.C. Spring Classic show held in Cloverdale, B.C., will be the official show for the B.C.M.H.C. Futurity. All entries must contain a completed entry form and the correct entry fees and be post marked by Feb. 15th of 2009. An additional late fee of \$50.00 must be enclosed with the nomination form if mailed after Feb. 15th. All entries must be received no later than Feb. 28th, 2009. It is strongly recommended you mail entries in early to avoid any postal problems.

FEE SCHEDULE:

2007 Foals: (2 years old in 2009)

By Feb. 15 th , 2009 (if horse entered in yearling futurity in 2008)	\$35.00
By Feb. 15 th , 2009 (Horses not entered as yearling previously in 2008)	\$170.00
After Feb. 15 th /09 to Feb. 28 th /09 <i>additional late fee added to entry fee</i>	\$50.00

2008 Foals: (1 year old in 2009)

By Feb. 15 th , 2009	\$35.00
After Feb. 15 th /09 to Feb. 28 th /09 <i>additional late fee added to entry fee</i>	\$50.00

There will be a \$25 class entry fee for the class at the show – see Spring Classic Program.

All horses to be judged by AMHA halter rules. Judges scores will be totalled for each horse.

GENERAL RULES:

To be eligible for the Futurity honours and prize money, entrants must be current in their futurity nominations, and be the registered owners of the AMHA Horse. **All horses must be shown in a regular halter class at the show. It can be Amateur, Open or Youth which ever is appropriate for the handler and horse.**

Horses to be shown in their appropriate sex class, male or female and by age.

In the event that the foal is sold before the Futurity class, Futurity eligibility is transferred to the new owner. The seller should provide the nomination and Futurity information to the new owner. The new owner must pay the fees when they come due to keep the horse eligible. They should also provide a new copy of the AMHA papers noting the ownership transfer. At time of showing the horses are to be shown under the current AMHA rules. Note all horses must reside in Canada, no exceptions.

CLOSING DATE:

As soon as any fees in the schedule become past due, that horse is no longer eligible for the futurity and the owner forfeits any fees paid up to that time.

No late or post entries will be accepted under any circumstances.

No refunds or substitutions for any reason.

Note – “NEW”: Foals to be nominated in utero by Dec. 31st/09 for eligibility for weanling futurity in 2010. Details to follow in up coming news letters.
